

# LDC GRADUATION OF ANGOLA

The graduation from the status of Least Developed Country (LDC) is based on three criteria: income per capita, human assets and economic vulnerability. In 2012, Angola was considered eligible for graduation from LDC status for the first time, as the country complied with the income-only graduation criterion. However, Angola did not meet the human assets and the economic vulnerability criteria.

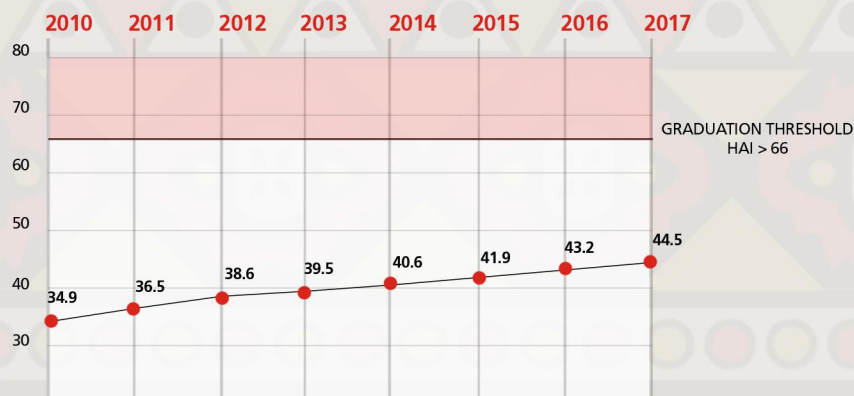
### Gross National Income (GNI) per capita

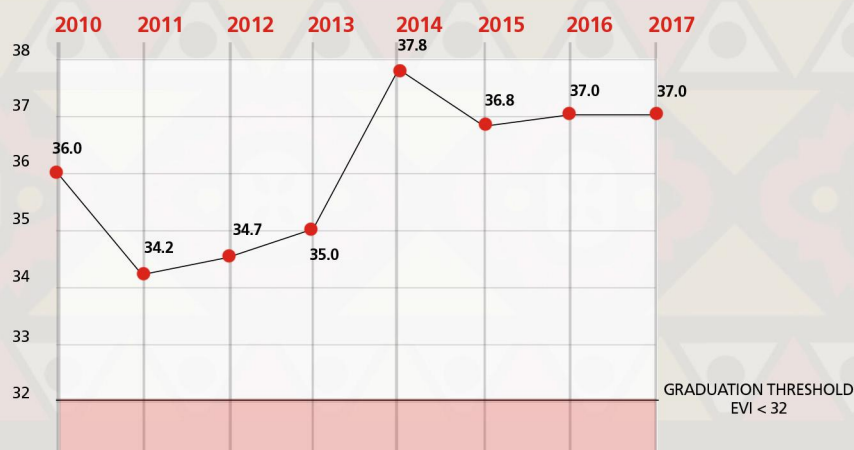
### Human Assets Index (HAI)
